*A bibliography should be in alphabetical order by the first word in each citation.*

## PRINT RESOURCES

### Book by a Single Author

Author's last name, author's first name. Title of Book. City of publication: publisher, copyright date.

Macaulay, David. The Way Things Work. Boston: Houghton Mifflin, 1988.

### Book by Two or More Authors

First author's last name, first name, and second author's name in normal order. Title of Book. City of publication: publisher, copyright date.

Comrie, Bernard, Stephen Matthews, and Maria Polinsky, eds. The Atlas of Languages. New York: Fact on File, 1996.

McLean, Bethany, and Peter Elkind. The Smartest Guys in the Room: the Amazing Rise and Scandalous Fall of Enron. New York: Penguin, 2003.

### Work in an Anthology

Author of the part of the book being cited. "Title of the piece." Title of the anthology. Word to designate credit for the book like compiler (comp.), editor (ed.) City of publication: Publisher, copyright date. Pages.

O'Brien, Tim. "On the Rainy River." Leaving Home. Comp. Hazel Rochman and Darlene Z. McCampbell. New York: Harper Collins, 1997. 133-156.

### An Article in a Reference Book

Author of the article (if no author begin with article title). "Title of article." Title of Book. Edition (if listed). Copyright date.

Littleton, C. Scott. "Mythology." The World Book Encyclopedia. 2001.

### An Article in a Magazine

Author's last name, first name. "Title of Article." Title of Magazine date: pages.

Kluger, Jeffrey. "Medicating Young Minds." Time 3 Nov. 2003: 48-58.

### An Article in a Newspaper

Author's last name, first name. "Title of article." Name of Newspaper date: pages.

Swartz, Jon. "Spam rage drives some e-mailers to extremes." USA Today 12 February 2004: 1-2.

## NONPRINT RESOURCES

### Film or Video Recording

Title. Director's name in normal order with Dir. preceding it. Performer's name in normal order if necessary to distinguish version with Perf. preceding. Original release date. Medium. Distributor, year of release of version.

Hamlet. Dir. Franco Zeffirelli. Perf. Mel Gibson, Glenn Close. 1990. DVD Warner Brothers, 2004.

### Sound Recording

Performer's, composer's or conductor's name in reverse order. Title of CD. Manufacturer, date.

Marsalis, Wynton. Classic Wynton. Sony, 1998.

*Note: impractically long urls may be truncated. In these cases, cite the url of the site's search page.*

### An Article from an Online Subscription Service (Newsbank, MaineDatabases—EBSCO, SIRS)

Author's last name, first name. "Title of Article." Title of Publication date of publication: pages.

Title of Subscription service. School or library where you accessed the site. Date you accessed the site <url>.

Author's last name, first name. "Title of Article." Title of Newspaper or Magazine date of publication. Date you accessed the site. <url>.

### Document from an Internet Site

Author's last name, first name. "Title of document." Electronic Publisher. Date of access <url>.
