Hebron Words Program


At Hebron, we are committed to helping students become effective communicators of meaningful ideas. Public speaking skills are taught with a unique focus for each grade level and are practiced in every classroom. So, whether explaining a math problem to the class at the whiteboard, expressing views as part of an economics debate, or sharing reflections on a piece of literature, students are guided to speak with confidence, voice, and life through a familiar common language. The Hebron Words Program includes "Last Word," a capstone speech given to the entire student body during senior year.


EDIE Program:

In order to equip our students to be innovators and leaders in this unprecedented age of global change, we offer the E.D.I.E. (Engineering, Design, Innovation, Entrepreneurship) Pathway. In this unique and holistically interdisciplinary curriculum, we immerse students in our area's landscape, heritage, and experiences to provide tangible opportunities to solve problems related to technology, community-building, ecology, food systems, and health and wellness. They may pursue technological engineering rooted in the Project Lead the Way (PLTW) curriculum and/or social innovation paths, both of which culminate in a senior capstone project. The students are empowered to engineer change in our local community and take the skills they have attained with them as they move onto college, careers, and lives as conscientious global citizens.

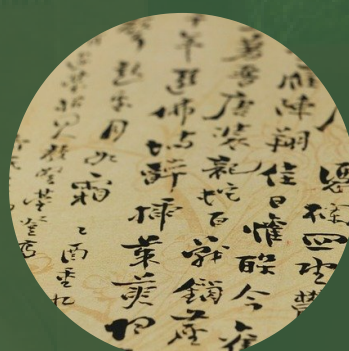
